General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A toilet located inside the Toddler Bathroom contained urine.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 13. Toys and Furnishings.

(1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:

- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and**
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. The School-Age Room contained tape residue on the side of the blue cabinet labeled supplies.
2. The Toddler Room contained black marker on the top of a shelving unit used to store toy cars.
3. The Toddler Room contained black marker on the top of a shelving unit used to store music items.

865 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

922 KAR 2:120. Section 13. Toys and Furnishings.

(2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:

- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;**
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;**
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and**
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A blue and white teeter-totter on the playground contained rust on the side metal bars of the unit.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 9. Food and Drink Requirements for All Child-Care Centers.

(3) A serving of milk shall consist of:

(a) Breast milk or iron-fortified formula for a child:

- 1. Age birth to twelve (12) months; or**
- 2. Beyond twelve (12) months of age as documented by the parent or the child's physician;**

(b) Pasteurized unflavored whole milk for children ages twelve (12) months to twenty-four (24) months; or

(c) Pasteurized unflavored low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. Two percent milk was observed inside the toddler room refrigerator and the hall refrigerator. The staff in charge indicated that she had served the two-to eight-year-old-children two percent milk at the end of last week and today for breakfast and lunch, because the store did not have one (1) percent or skim milk. A serving of milk shall consist of pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(b) A written record for each child:

- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;**
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and**
- 3. To contain:**
 - a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;**
 - b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:**
 - (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;**
 - (ii) Family physician; and**
 - (iii) Preferred hospital;**
 - c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;**
 - d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:**
 - (i) Allergies;**
 - (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and**
 - (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;**
 - e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;**
 - f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;**

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A child enrolled on 8/12/2018, did not have a physician's contact number on file. This area was left blank in the enrollment paperwork.

- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and**
- (b) Documented.**

(13) An earthquake drill, shelter-in-place or lockdown drill, and tornado drill shall be:

- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and**
- (b) Documented.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. There was no written evidence of lockdown or shelter-in-place drills. Lockdown or shelter-in-place drills shall be conducted quarterly and documented.
