(4) Each toilet shall:
(a) Be kept in clean condition;

(d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a toilet seat located in the Preschool Restroom was broken; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair. Staff was not aware of the issue stating the toilet seat would be fixed as soon as possible.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(c) Daily attendance records documenting the arrival and departure time of each child, including records that are required in accordance with 922 KAR 2:160, Section 13, if a child receives services from the child-care center through the Child Care Assistance Program;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the arrival times for eleven (11) children were documented on the daily attendance record for 12/28/2020. There were sixteen (16) children present; therefore, the daily attendance record for 12/28/2020 was not being accurately maintained. Staff reported parents often forget to sign their children into the child care center on the daily attendance records.

1170 - Professional Development

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found a staff's (DOH: 9/17/19) file contained a professional development plan that was dated 10/14/19; therefore, the staff's annual written plan for professional development needs to be updated. Staff confirmed through interview that the staff's professional development plan needs to be updated.
