Staff Requirements.</p> <p>(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:</p> <p>(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;</p> <p>(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and</p> <p>(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.</p> <p>(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.</p>	
Findings:	
General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-Tris, the surveyor found that a staff's (DOH: 02/21/2021) file did not contain documentation of one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; therefore, the training was not completed within one (1) year of employment.

 - (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;**
 - (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and**
 - (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

1. On the ledge between the Toddler and Preschool Classrooms, one (1) spray bottle of Great Value Disinfectant Spray was labeled, "Keep Out of Reach of Children."
2. On the ledge between the Toddler and Preschool Classrooms, one (1) canister of Kleen Freak Disinfecting Wipes was labeled, "Keep Out of Reach of Children."

Both items were seen to be within reach of and accessible to children.

585 - Premises Requirements

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found one (1) vent located in the Two Year Old Classroom that had a coating of dust; therefore, the premises was not kept in clean condition.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a water hose on the playground that was unrolled on the ground beside the stairs to the Two Year Old Classroom; therefore, the playground was not safe from a foreseeable hazard.

General: Based on observation of the playground, the surveyor found one (1) green Little Tykes car that had a door broken off which was on the ground; therefore, the toy was not kept in good condition.

- (9) Bottles shall be:**
 - (a) Individually labeled;**
 - (b) Promptly refrigerated;**
 - (c) Covered while not in use; and**
 - (d) Consumed within one (1) hour of being heated or removed from the refrigerator.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation of the kitchen refrigerator, the surveyor found one (1) bottle with eight (8) ounces of milk that did not have a lid; therefore, the bottle was not covered properly.

Staff in charge stated that the bottle had been stored in the refrigerator since 9:00 a.m.
