Findings:

General: Based on interview, the surveyor learned the following:

1. On 10/26/12, a two-year-old male child had been being disruptive and not wanting to stay buckled in the stroller. The staff person contacted the parent to come and pick up the child. The staff placed the child in the toddler room with the younger children and did not permit him to go to the playground with the other two-year-old children.
2. On 11/16/12, a three-year-old female had been disruptive by screaming and yelling while on her mat in the nap room. The staff removed her from the classroom, calmed her down and the director placed her in the toddler room with the toddler room staff. After the director left the room to finish cleaning up the dining area, the female child began to scream and yell again. The female child slapped the toddler room teacher on the arm.
