**Findings:**

General: Based on Interview, it was found in interviews with five (5) children, chosen at random, that all five (5) children disclosed that as a form of discipline, they were made to do wall squats for approximately five (5) minutes. The children stated that they are made to get up towards the wall with their backs towards the wall and they have to squat, like they were sitting in a chair with knees bent and hold their arms straight out in front of them. All five ( 5) children stated that it hurts when they are made to do the squats. The children stated that it was not the entire group but individual children that has to do this.
