General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the center did not have current liability insurance on file. The liability insurance was valid from 12/6/20 to 12/6/21.

General: Based on observation and interview, a cord, approximately twelve (12) inches long, hung down from the side of the television and was plugged into an outlet in the two-year-old's room. The cord was accessible to the ten (10) children present in the room.
