For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;</p> <p>Findings: General: Based on interview and review of documentation, it was found that a two-year-old child was left alone and unsupervised on the playground from 10:59AM to 12:08PM. This was due to a breakdown in staff following the facility's policies and procedures set in place. It should be noted that the child was found safe and unharmed on the playground.</p>

Therefore, the facility did not provide a safe environment for the child while in care. It should be noted that this facility is located next to a main road which posed another risk to the child while she was outside on the playground.</p>
