(l) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;	
Findings:	
General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the children's bathroom area in Room #5 (two-year-olds), the surveyor observed a toilet plunger and a sponge mop positioned beside the toilet. This manner of storage is not sanitary and promotes the spread of germs.

(7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:	
(a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;	
(b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and	
(c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.	
Findings:	
General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of Room #6 (four-year-olds), the surveyor observed a staff purse hanging on a hook on the back of the classroom door. The purse was accessible to the children.

540 - Premises Requirements

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (1) The premises shall be:
 - (a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
 - (b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. The carpet in Room #6 (four-year-olds) contained an excessive amount of debris (food crumbs, dirt particles and pieces of paper) all throughout the room.
2. The carpet in the gym and stairwell leading to the lower level of the building contained numerous dried leaves and dirt particles.
3. The transition strip separating the tile floor from the carpet area was missing on two sides of the room in Room #10. Numerous dirt particles and grime had collected in these areas.

650 - Toilet

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
 - (a) Be kept in clean condition;
 - (b) Be kept in good repair;
 - (c) Be in a lighted room; and
 - (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The toilet in the gym area (lower level) contained a dark ring around the inside of the toilet bowl.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor observed a table with a broken leg turned upside down on the floor in Room #10.
