(a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
(b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, it was found that a seven-year-old child was in the classroom bathroom with the door stuck for approximately 10 minutes. During this time the child was asking for help to get out of the bathroom, but the staff member refused to help him. In addition, the staff member did not allow other children to help open the bathroom door. When the child came out of the bathroom, the staff member reminded him that he was told not to close the door. At that time, the child started to cry as other children in the classroom were making fun of him. Therefore, the facility did not provide a safe environment for the child or assure the child's comfort while in care.

Findings:

During this time the child was asking for help, but the staff member refused to help him or allow other children to help. When the child emerged from the bathroom, he was humiliated as other children were laughing at him and he began to cry.
