Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff member hired 8/12/2019, did not have proof of educational qualifications in their personnel file.

410 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.
(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, two staff members did not complete 15-hours of Cabinet-approved training.

Findings:

General: Based on observation:

- 1. The three-year-old classroom had several areas of chipping paint on the walls. Additionally, there were crayon marks on the door.
- 2. There was chipping paint on the wall near the dramatic play center and circle time space in the school-aged classroom.
- 3. There were several areas of chipping and flaking paint located in the book center of the one-year-old classroom; additionally, the paint on the classroom door was flaking.
- 4. There was one water-stained ceiling tile in the corner of the Creepers classroom.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the surveyor observed pizza being served to the children in care. One staff member stated that the children are served Giovanni's pizza on Wednesdays. The facility did not maintain an agreement or contract stating what meals would be provided from the caterer, nor a copy of the food service permit for the caterer.

General: Based on observation, there were three packets of frozen breast milk stored in the Creeper classroom freezer. The breast milk packets were not labeled with a child's name.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one did not have a physician contact, preferred hospital, or emergency care authorization in their enrollment packet. Additionally, two children did not have a preferred hospital listed in their enrollment packet.
