922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (7) Except in accordance with subsection (8) of this section, the following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
 - (b) Knives and sharp objects;
 - (c) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids;
 - (d) Plastic bags;
 - (e) Litter and rubbish;
 - (f) Bar soap; and
 - (g) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a pedestal fan faced the three (3) and four (4) year olds' room, the fan cord was connected to a sixteen (16) foot extension cord that extended from the fan to an outlet in the break room. This cord was accessible to the children and was a tripping hazard. Also, a utility cord connected to a fan cord in the two (2) year olds' room extended sixteen (16) feet across the floor to an outlet in the foyer. These cords were accessible to the children in care and were a tripping hazard.

550 - Building Temperature
