(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(b) A written record for each child:

1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;

2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and

3. To contain:

a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;

b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:

(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;

(ii) Family physician; and

(iii) Preferred hospital;

c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;

d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:

(i) Allergies;

(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and

(iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;

e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;

f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a child enrolled on 09/11/20, did not have the phone number for the physician listed in the enrollment information. In addition, five (5) children enrolled on 09/11/20, 07/10/19, 01/27/20, 05/24/16, and 04/25/17, each did not include the health status on allergies in the enrollment information.
