**922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.**  
**(1) A licensee shall:**  
**(a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and**  
**(b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.**

**Findings:**

General: Based on observation, three chairs of varying sizes were stacked in the Birth- to Two-year-old classroom; this presents a safety hazard.

**520 - Inaccessible Items** **Not In Compliance**

**922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.**  
**(7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:**  
**(a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;**  
**(b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and**  
**(c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.**

**Findings:**

General: Based on observation during a tour of the Birth- to Two-year-old classroom, the surveyor observed that the cabinet under the sink was not locked; the sink housed Windex cleaning spray. This spray was accessible to the children in care.

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**922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.**  
**(1) A child-care center shall maintain:**  
**(b) A written record for each child:**  
**1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;**  
**2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and**  
**3. To contain:**  
**a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;**  
**b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:**  
**(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;**  
**(ii) Family physician; and**  
**(iii) Preferred hospital;**  
**c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;**  
**d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:**  
**(i) Allergies;**  
**(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and**  
**(iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;**  
**e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;**  
**f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;**

**Findings:**

General: Based on review of documentation, one child did not have a physician contact number listed within their enrollment information.

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**922 KAR 2:410E. Emergency Regulation.**  
**Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:410E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.**

**Findings:**

General: Based on observation, there were dress-up clothes stored in a purple bin in the Two- to Four-year-old classroom; machine washable toys should be removed during the COVID-19 state of emergency to prevent the spread of germs and bacteria.
