**Findings:**

General: Based on Interview, a one-year-old child was bitten by another one-year-old child at least four (4) times on 10/5/16 in the younger toddler classroom. The staff present stated that she was changing a diaper when she heard a child crying and saw one child on top of another child. She said that she separated the children and observed "a couple" of bite marks on a child's back and one (1) on her right arm. The incident report filled out by the staff person present indicates "multiple" bite marks.

Some of the meals observed were as follows: 1) Pizza and grapes; 2) Goldfish crackers, chips, fruit snacks, Apple Jacks cereal and juice; 3) Ham/cheese sandwich, Doritos, fruit snacks and Capri Sun; 4) Peanut butter & jelly sandwich, Goldfish crackers, pretzels and lemonade.
