Further interview with staff found that the four (4) and five-year-old children are kept in an awake room where they are provided with various activities. Further interview found that provisions are not made for all of the children to nap.</p>

(5) A child who does not sleep shall be permitted to play quietly and shall be visually supervised.</p> <p>Findings: General: Based on Interview, it was found that in the three-year-old room if a child does not go to sleep after thirty (30) or forty-five (45) minutes they are sometimes given a book to look at quietly while sitting on their cot. However, one (1) staff person indicated that she does not do this every day. This same staff person also indicated that if a child does not lay quietly and stay on their cot she will make them stay in a "Safe Place" for three (3) minutes the next time they go outside. The staff person indicated during interview she did not want to reward a child for getting off their cot.</p>
