Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, ant insecticide was placed in an area that was accessible to children.

During interviews with staff, the surveyor found that on 12/9/2020, at approximately 11:40 a.m., a 22-month-old toddler found a Terro liquid ant bait cartridge, and placed it in her mouth.

The staff person, who witnessed the incident, found the child standing on the platform of a climbing structure, and chewing on plastic. The staff person removed the plastic from the child's mouth and found that it was Terro liquid ant bait. It is unknown if the toddler ingested any of the insecticide, but as a precaution, the staff person rinsed the child's mouth, washed her hands, and notified the staff person in charge. The staff person in charge contacted Poison Control and the child's parents. The child's mother transported her to the hospital for further evaluation.

Interviews with staff found that they were unaware that ant bait was in the eating area. However, it was later revealed that a maintenance staff person had placed three Terro liquid ant bait cartridges in the toddler eating area during the Thanksgiving break: one behind the diapering table, and two behind a bench. The surveyor moved the diapering table and bench and found two ant bait cartridges that contained liquid insecticide. It is important to note, the maintenance staff person disposed of the ant bait in the surveyors presence.
