<p><b>922 KAR 2:100 - Section 10. Standards for the Provider.</b></p> <p>(2) A provider shall not provide care for more unrelated children than the number authorized on the certificate of operation.</p> <p>(3) If a provider cares for more than four (4) infants, including the provider's own or related infants, the provider shall have an assistant present.</p> <p>(4) A provider shall not care for more than six (6) children under the age of six (6) years old, including the provider's own or related children.</p> <p><b>Findings:</b></p> <p>General: Based on Review of Documentation, the provider was approved to care for six (6) unrelated children, but cared for ten (10) unrelated children at approximately 4:00 pm on 11/01/16. Also, the provider cared for nine (9) unrelated children at 3:10 pm on 01/03/17.</p>	
<b>30 - Total Capacity</b>	<b>Not In Compliance</b>
<p><b>922 KAR 2:100 - Section 10. Standards for the Provider.</b></p> <p>(5) The maximum number of unrelated children in the care of a certified family child-care home provider shall not exceed six (6) at any one (1) time. A provider may care for four (4) related children in addition to six (6) unrelated children for a maximum child care capacity of ten (10) at any one (1) time.</p> <p><b>Findings:</b></p> <p>General: Based on Review of Documentation, the provider cared for eleven (11) to fifteen (15) children at one (1) time in her home, which exceeded the approved capacity in November 2016. This occurred twenty (20) days out of twenty-two (22) days the provider operated in November 2016.</p>
