Findings: General: Based on a review of centers written policies and procedures on reporting suspected abuse and on discipline, a staff member observed another staff member slap a one-year-old child across her face at 11:10 am on 04/23/19. The caregiver completed her shift at 12:00 pm and did not report her observations until the morning of 04/24/19 at 7:30 am. The center's policy stated anyone would immediately report to the proper authorities.

Findings: General: Based on observation, a review of a video recording of the one-year olds' classroom on 04/23/19 determined a caregiver wiped a child's face and arms with a cloth wipe. The caregiver then used the same cloth wipe on another one-year olds child's face and arms.
