Findings: General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the center's inappropriate interaction with children policy stated an inappropriate tone and discipline of children will not be tolerated. Children are not to be spoken to with angry voices and in manners that are not calm. Staff must exhibit patience at all times or take a break when necessary. If incidents of inappropriate interaction between a child and a staff member are reported to the director by staff or parent, staff will receive a written warning. The policy was not followed when a caregiver told two (2), two-year-old children to sit against the wall, grabbed the children underneath their arms and pulled the children across the floor to the wall at approximately 5:30 p.m. on 03/17/2021. In addition, the caregiver received verbal warnings for loudness with children and rudeness to staff but the caregiver never received written warnings.
