922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.
(10) When a child is diapered, the child shall:
(b) Be placed on a surface that is:
 1. Clean;
 2. Padded;
 3. Free of holes, rips, tears, or other damage;
 4. Nonabsorbent;
 5. Easily cleaned; and
 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a mounted diaper changing station in the restroom. The surface was not padded. The director presented a disposable pad that she uses underneath the children when diapering. She stated she then disposes of the pad after each diaper change. The disposable pads presented were of absorbent material.
