<p>Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The surveyor reviewed facility video footage with two administrative staff during the investigation and found that on 10/9/19, at 4:31PM, a one-year-old, male child opened the gate in the doorway of the Toddler 1 Classroom which allowed six children to exit the classroom. It is important to note that the video shows the two staff present in the room standing at a half wall in the classroom, which is used to separate the classroom from the toddler eating area/food prep area. The staff have their backs positioned toward the children and appear to be working on something and talking to each other at the time of the incident. The staff were not aware that the children had exited the classroom until approximately fifty seconds later. At this time one of the staff can be seen on video walking out of the room to retrieve the children from the hallway. An interview with staff and a review of documentation found that six children (one-year-olds) were alone and unsupervised in the hallway approximately fifty seconds. Staff stated that the latch on the gate was not secure when the incident occurred. A new gate was purchased and installed the day after the incident.</p>
