Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the kitchen door was propped open at the time of the survey. The kitchen leads into the laundry room and a break room. Both the laundry room and break room doors were also found to be open. The following items were found: 1) There were several knives in an unlocked kitchen drawer. 2) The oven was on with the temperature set to 175 degrees. 3) There were numerous empty plastic bags found in an unlocked kitchen cabinet. 4) There was kitchen cleaner, Lysol, GooGone, Dawn and Easy Off Oven cleaner found in an unlocked kitchen cabinet. 5) There were numerous bottles of bleach found in the laundry room. 6) There were paint cans and paint thinner found on a low shelf in the break room. All of these items were accessible to the children.
