General: Based on observation and interview, a staff person witnessed another staff person walk over to a preschool child, grab the child by the left upper arm and yank the child up quickly from a chair and force the child into another classroom center which was a few feet from the chair. According to the witness, the child then curled up into a fetal position on the floor with her head in her hands visibly upset.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.
(10) A child shall not be subjected to:
(a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);
(b) Loud, profane, threatening, frightening, humiliating, or abusive language; or
(c) Discipline that is associated with:
1. Rest;
2. Toileting; or
3. Food.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, a staff person witnessed another staff person walk over to a preschool child, grab the child by the left upper arm and yank the child up quickly from a chair and force the child into another classroom center which was a few feet away from the chair. According to the witness, the child then curled up into a fetal position on the floor with her head in her hands visibly upset. This same staff person had been verbally reprimanded in the past for her tone of voice with children.
