Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, six (6) caregivers each hired on 8/20/20, did not have an annual professional development plan on file.

Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, a monthly, practiced fire drill was not conducted in October through December 2020 and January and February 2021. Also, a quarterly, practiced earthquake and tornado drill was not conducted in the third quarter of 2020.
