 1. High school diploma;
 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:
 General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver, hired 07/15/21, did not have education verification on file.

405 - TB Verification **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.
(1) Child-care center staff:
(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:
 General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver, hired 06/21/21, did not have TB verification on file.

- (7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:**
 - (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;**
 - (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and**
 - (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a gray plastic bag, which contained ten (10) plastic bags, was stored in a crate on the wall and was accessible to children in the two and three-year-olds' restroom.

605 - Building Requirements

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (5) The building shall be constructed to ensure the:**
 - (a) Building is:**
 - 1. Dry;**
 - 2. Ventilated; and**
 - 3. Well lit, including clean light fixtures that are:**
 - a. In good repair in all areas; and**
 - b. Shielded or have shatter-proof bulbs installed; and**
 - (b) Following are protected:**
 - 1. Windows;**
 - 2. Doors;**
 - 3. Stoves;**
 - 4. Heaters;**
 - 5. Furnaces;**
 - 6. Pipes; and**
 - 7. Stairs.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, dead bugs were inside two (2) light fixtures in both restrooms used by school-age children.

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

- (9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a ceiling tile was torn in the school-age restroom.

695 - Toilet

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:**
 - (a) Be kept in clean condition;**
 - (b) Be kept in good repair;**
 - (c) Be in a lighted room; and**
 - (d) Have ventilation to outside air.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a dark brown substance was in the toilet in the three-year-olds' restroom.
