(l) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on Interview, and Review of Documentation, the childcare staff failed to maintain the health, safety and comfort of all children in care. Interview with a previous staff member with a hire date of 04/29/2014 revealed that on August 29, 2014 she revealed that she "patted" a two-year-old child due to the lack of following instructions. Continued interview with the staff member revealed that she also grabbed the two-year-old by the arm to attempt to gain control over the child to make her sit in a chair. Interview of a witness of the "patting" of the child revealed that she was dropping off her daughter for childcare when she saw the staff member with the hire date of 04/29/2014 "jerk up a little girl by her arm and slap her on her leg twice." Review of a written statement by the Director revealed that the staff member with the hire date of 04/29/2014 admitted to "patting" a child to get her to sit down.

- (10) A child shall not be subjected to:**
(a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);
(b) Loud, profane, threatening, frightening, or abusive language; or
(c) Discipline that is associated with:
1. Rest;
2. Toileting; or
3. Food.

Findings:

General: Based on Interview, the childcare center staff failed to ensure that a child should not be subjected to physical discipline, as a means of punishment, discipline, behavior modification, or for any other reason. Interview with a staff member with the hire date of 04/29/2014 revealed that she used physical discipline on a two-year-old child on 08/29/2014 as punishment on the child due to the lack of following directions. Continued interview with the staff member with the hire date of 04/29/2014 revealed that the two-year-old child that was "patted" on 08/29/2014 was previously misbehaving by biting children and hitting children, but was not "patted" during those incidents.
