922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services. (3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child will be: 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who: a. Ensures the child is within scope of vision and range of voice; or b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice; Findings: General: Based on Interview, the child care center failed to maintain adequate supervision in accordance with regulatory requirements. Interviews revealed that while on a field trip two girls, ages seven (7) and eleven (11) years old, were allowed to accompany each other to the rest room. Continued interview revealed the two (2) girls were out of the scope of vision and range of voice for a staff member in charge which resulted in one child inappropriately touching the other girl. A collection of information through interviews revealed the inappropriate touching to be kissing on the neck and touching of the private area while in the rest room.
