**(e) A current personnel file for each child-care center staff person to include:**  
 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;  
 2. Proof of educational qualifications;  
 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;  
 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and  
 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

**Findings:**

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

- Two staff members did not have documented hire dates on file. The staff in charge verbally gave the surveyor the hire dates.
- Three staff members did not have the results of the national criminal background check on file. The fingerprint pages were on file, but not the results indicating that the staff were eligible for employment.

**Findings:**

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A substitute staff member hired on 2/06/2012, did not have a current TB skin test result on file. The TB skin test on file was dated 2/21/2018.

  - (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
  - (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

2. A substitute staff member did not complete any cabinet-approved early care and education training hours during her completed training year. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.
3. One staff member completed 10 cabinet-approved early care and education training hours during her completed training year. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. In the main classroom of building #1, a child-size table contained a small area of chipped paint on the surface. This table was located next to the book area.
