(2) Activity areas, equipment, and materials shall be arranged so that the child's activity is adequately supervised by staff.	
Findings:	
<p>General: Based on observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. On 1/20/2021, a staff member was assisting a child in the bathroom while the other staff member was cleaning the tables and preparing for lunch in the Pre-K classroom. The staff member in the bathroom assisting a child indicated that she could see the children in the Pre-K room while she was standing inside the bathroom doorway until she had to kneel down to help clean a child. The staff member stated that when she was kneeling down she could not see over the shelving unit in the block area. The staff member indicated that she was in the bathroom for approximately 4-6 minutes and then she exited the bathroom and began to walk around the classroom. The staff member stated that when she went to the block area, she observed a male child laying on his back with another male child leaning over him and the child leaning over had his mouth on the other child's genital area. The staff member discussed with the children about keeping their body parts private and then informed the staff person in charge of this incident. Based on interviews, parents of both children were informed of the incident.</p>
