General: Based on Review of Documentation, there was an employee who did not have an evaluation completed for their previous year of employment.

265 - Health, Safety, Comfort Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.
(1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
(l) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there were two (2) cribs in the Nursery Room that were filled with toys. Both cribs are used for napping.

275 - Caregiver Alone Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.
(1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
(n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in Section 3(1)(e)6 of this administrative regulation;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff person hired on 4/10/17 did not have copies of their child abuse check or criminal records check in their personnel file. There was no evidence on file that the applications for either of these checks had been completed. The staff person in charge stated that they had sent off the documentation but did not keep records of it at the facility. This staff person was observed working alone for the duration of the survey.

300 - Background checks/left alone

- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.**

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff person hired on 4/10/17 did not have copies of their child abuse check or criminal records check in their personnel file. There was no evidence on file that the applications for either of these checks had been completed. The staff person in charge stated that they had sent off the documentation but did not keep records of it at the facility. This staff person was observed working alone for the duration of the survey.

315 - Educational Requirements

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff person hired on 4/10/17 did not have a evidence of their education in their personnel file.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff person with a hire date of 5/8/16 did not have copies in their personnel file indicating they are free of TB.

340 - Training

(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;**
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and**
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.**

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff person with a hire date of 5/8/16 had not completed the required six (6) hours of orientation training. This information was confirmed through the ECE TRIS system as well.

- (c) That provides experience to promote the individual child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and well-being; and
- (d) That offers a variety of creative activities including the following:
 - 1. Art;
 - 2. Music;
 - 3. Dramatic play;
 - 4. Stories and books;
 - 5. Science;
 - 6. Block building;
 - 7. Tactile activity;
 - 8. Culture;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, upon entering the facility, this surveyor observed the preschool teacher sitting on a couch on her phone. The children were in the corner of the room playing. The daily schedule stated that circle time was scheduled during this period of time. Additionally the after school room did not contain any supplies for the curriculum areas of music, dramatic play, books, science, blocks, tactile and cultural. The items were not seen stored in any other area of the facility to indicate that they are brought out when the school age children arrive. The staff person in charge stated that they have to share the space with the church so they have to remove some of the items that are in that room each day for before the children arrive.

General: Based on Observation, there was a cabinet in the preschool area that had a child safety lock on the inside, but when pulled the cabinet opened and the lock was not working. There was a can of Lysol spray inside the cabinet that was accessible to the children.

- (c) Pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there was a gallon of 2% milk in the refrigerator that was used during breakfast for the children. There was also a gallon of 1% milk but it was unopened and had not been used. The staff person in charge stated that someone else had done the shopping and had picked up the wrong milk.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, there was one (1) child's file that contained an expired immunization form. The child's immunizations had expired on 3/23/17.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, there were three (3) children's files that did not have a preferred hospital listed for the children to be taken to in case of an emergency. Also, one of those files was missing the information for the child's physician as well. A parent's signature was also missing for one of the children's emergency authorization on the application.
