Findings: General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, a caregiver sprayed two (2) children with a spray mop filled with a cleaning solution, at approximately 4:45 pm on 01/24/19, in the three-year-olds' room. In addition, the caregiver picked up children by their arm.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements. (6) Cots, equipment, and furnishings used for sleeping and napping shall be spaced twelve (12) inches apart to allow free and safe movement by a person.	
Findings: General: Based on Observation, two (2) children slept on an individual cot that was spaced less than twelve (12) inches from another cot in the four-year-olds' room.
